Presentations

Logan Health School Based Clinic Presentation-

Josh Simonds explained to the Board that Logan Health's mission is to improve the health, academics and success of the students. He added that Logan Health is applying for a grant through the Montana Healthcare Foundation to support the initial equipment and staffing expense. He said that after the grant money is spent, Logan Health- Shelby will continue the service indefinitely using any revenues from the services to support the cost. He added that schools are impacted in a positive way for having these services at the schools.

Marias Healthcare School Based Clinic Presentaion-

Jamie Brownell told the Board on the services that Marias Healthcare will be providing to the students and staff at the district. She said that a counselor will be available for 2 days a week and that a nurse will be available 5 days a week. She added that the clinic will get \$350,000 for two years and after that it will renew yearly. If the grant money will no longer be available the expenses will roll into the main budget of 10 million. She also said that by mid-summer the clinic will know if they will get the grant.
